Use the five steps of **OPTIC** to analyze a text

- **O** is for *overview* what the text appears to be about (after reading through it once);
- **P** is for *parts* of the text elements/details that seem important (consider some of the biggies, such as setting, character, point of view, conflict, plot, diction, details, imagery, language, and syntax);
- **T** is for *title* highlight the words of the title and consider how they point toward the big idea the author intends for readers to take away from their reading of the text;
- I is for *interrelationships* try treating the title as the subject and the parts of the text as clues to detect and specify the interrelationships in the work;
- **C** is for *conclusion* draw a conclusion about the meaning of the text as a whole. What does the story/poem/play/novel say about life? State the theme (big idea) of the work in a single sentence.
