

## **APE Lit. & Comp. Assignments**

### **Weeks 23 & 24 (February 3-14, 2014)**

**Wednesday, February 5, 2014:** Students took notes over an introductory video about William Shakespeare.

**Thursday, February 6, 2014:** Students read a chapter about sonnets from *How to Read Literature Like a Professor* (Chapter 4: If it's a Square, it's a Sonnet), and took brief notes on various aspects of Italian and English sonnet forms. Students received information about the sonnet paper and presentation, and their randomly selected sonnet number for use with that assignment. Students are to read through all assignment information and locate a copy of their sonnets as homework.

**Friday, February 7, 2014:** Students completed multiple-choice practice, reviewed answers, reviewed answers from last week's multiple-choice practice, and received an anticipation guide for *Hamlet* that is to be completed before returning to class Monday, when it will be due.

**Monday, February 10, 2014:** Students completed a pre-reading activity as bell work and read Act I, scene i of *Hamlet*. Students are to continue working on their sonnet papers and presentations as homework. The paper and presentation will be due at the start of class Friday, February 21, 2014.

**Tuesday, February 11, 2014:** Students completed a pre-reading activity as bell work and read Act I, scene ii of *Hamlet*. Students are to continue working on their sonnet papers and presentations as homework. The paper and presentation will be due at the start of class Friday, February 21, 2014.

**Wednesday, February 12, 2014:** Students completed a pre-reading activity as bell work and read all of Act I, scene iii of *Hamlet*. Students are to continue working on their sonnet papers and presentations as homework. The paper and presentation will be due at the start of class Friday, February 21, 2014.

**Thursday, February 13, 2014:** Students read Act I, scenes iv-v of *Hamlet*, and began viewing the complete first act in film. Students are to continue working on their sonnet papers and presentations as homework. The paper and presentation will be due at the start of class Friday, February 21, 2014.
