APE Lit. & Comp. Class Activities and Assignments Weeks 15 & 16 (November 21-December 2, 2016)

Monday, November 21, 2016: Students in periods 1 & 7 finished viewing a film adaptation of *Jane Eyre*. Students in periods 3,4,& 6 participated in the school-wide ACT review. There is no homework in AP English this week.

Tuesday, November 22, 2016: Students who were present participated in a show and tell which included various videos. There is no homework assigned in AP English for the rest of the week.

Monday, November 28, 2016: Students came into class and reviewed some aspects of Victorian history and society with the teacher before reading "The Story of an Hour" by Kate Chopin. Students then received a copy of the "Beefing up Commentary" worksheet and used remaining class time to complete it. As homework, students are to finish the worksheet--it will be due at the start of class tomorrow.

Friday, December 2, 2016: Students entered class and picked up instructions, along with a copy of the review/study guide for *A Doll House*. Students were allowed to work alone, or with 1-2 classmates to complete all questions and tasks on the review sheet. The review/study guide answers and work will be due at the start of class Monday, December 5, 2016. As homework, students are to finish all study guide work and review the play in preparation for the upcoming test over *A Doll House*.
